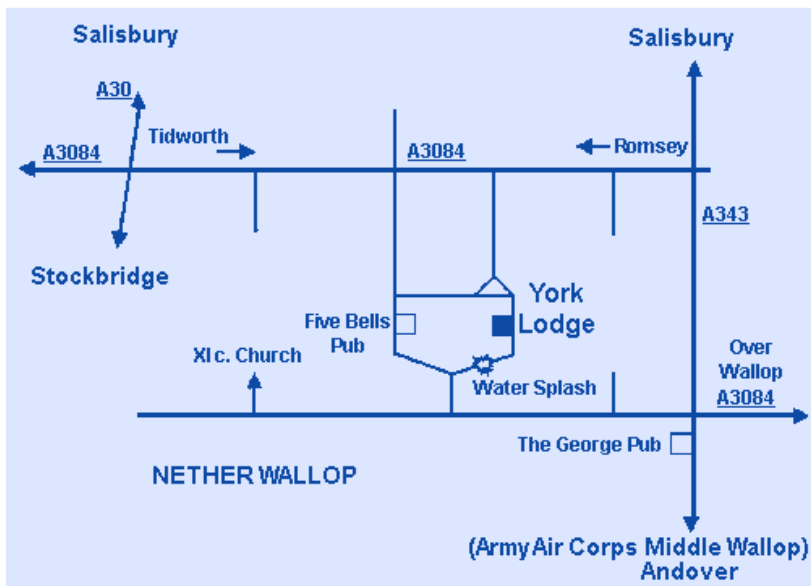
The well-appointed and comfortable accommodation is in a self-contained wing of a charming modern house in a secluded, peaceful garden. The picturesque village of Nether Wallop was used as setting for Agatha Christie's "Miss Marples" series and is also famous for its XI century Church with the oldest Anglo Saxon wall paintings still in situ in the country. The village pub (with good food) is in walking distance and there are many excellent pubs and restaurants in Stockbridge (10 minutes' drive) and surrounding villages. Equidistant from the Cathedral cities of Winchester and Alisbury, and within easy reach of Stonehenge, this is an ideal base for exploring southern England and is also a convenient stop-over for touring the West Country.

DIRECTIONS



From Andover and A 303

Take the A343 towards Salisbury and about 6 miles from Andover go past Army Air Corps Centre. Go down hill into The Wallops, carry on straight over x roads by The George Pub (still on A343) up to the top of the hill and turn left off A343 on to B3084 signed Romsey and Broughton. Take 2nd left turn after 0.9 mile down HOSKETTS LANE (unsigned, single track, bottom of dip.) Fork left into FIVE BELLS LANE, and York Lodge is first house on right with automatic wooden gates.

From Stockbridge

Take A30 towards Salisbury. Ignore signs to The Wallops until you reach B3084 signed Tidworth and the Wallops. Turn right. Take 3rd right turn down HOSKETTS LANE, unsigned, single track, bottom of dip. Fork left into FIVE BELLS LANE and York Lodge is first house on right with automatic wooden gates.
